



**COWICHAN VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT**  
**BYLAW No. 4601**

**A Bylaw to Amend Bylaw No. 4412 – Solid Waste Fees and Regulations Bylaw, 2022**

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**WHEREAS** the Board of Directors of the Cowichan Valley Regional District established a scale of charges for its solid waste disposal facilities under the provisions of Bylaw No. 4412, cited as "*CVRD Bylaw No. 4412 – Solid Waste Fees and Regulations Bylaw, 2022*";

**AND WHEREAS** the Board deems it necessary to modify Section 2 - *DEFINITIONS* to reflect updates to materials and amend SCHEDULE A – *REGULATION AND FEES FOR SOLID WASTE* of Bylaw No. 4412 to reflect updates to processes and fees for managing garbage and recyclable materials;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Board of Directors of the Cowichan Valley Regional District, in an open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **CITATION**

This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "**CVRD Bylaw No. 4601 – Solid Waste Fees and Regulations Amendment Bylaw, 2024**".

2. **AMENDMENT**

That CVRD Bylaw No. 4412 be amended by:

- a) replacing the line "Regulations for Deposting Solid Waste" with "Regulations for Depositing Solid Waste" in the Bylaw 4412 title section to address a spelling error;
- b) deleting, in its entirety, "*Section 2. DEFINITIONS*" and replacing it with "*Section 2. DEFINITIONS*" attached to this bylaw;
- c) deleting, in its entirety, "*SCHEDULE A – REGULATIONS AND FEES FOR SOLID WASTE*" and replacing it with "*SCHEDULE A – REGULATIONS AND FEES FOR SOLID WASTE*" attached to this bylaw.

3. **FORCE AND EFFECT**

## 2. DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

**“Ammunition”** means objects containing explosive powder or projectiles that can be shot, fired, scattered, dropped, or detonated from a weapon, such as bullets or shells.

**“Antifreeze”** means a liquid, such as ethylene glycol or alcohol, that may be mixed with water and was intended to be used in a radiator or similar component, but does not contain lubricating oil or petroleum products and that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Antifreeze Containers”** means empty containers that held antifreeze that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Appliances, Large”** include but are not limited to fridges, freezers, range hoods, washing machines and cookstoves that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**. **Appliances, Large** may, or may not, contain **ODS**.

**“Asbestos Containing Material”** means the following:

- a. an article or material that is determined to contain at least 0.5% **Friable** or non-**Friable** asbestos using a method specified in Section 40 (1) of the **Hazardous Waste Regulation**; or,
- b. material suspected by the **Manager** of the **CVRD** to contain at least 0.5% **Friable** or non-**Friable** asbestos or material that does not have accompanying documentation verifying that it is asbestos-free; or,
- c. Vermiculite insulation.

**“Ash & Soot”** means the carbonaceous residue created by the combustion of organic matter.

**“Asphalt”** means a petroleum by-product, mixed with gravel, crushed rock or similar material, used for paving roadways, driveways, parking areas, and other surfaces.

**“Batteries”** means common dry-cell, single-use, or rechargeable household batteries that need to be replaced when they lose their charge or cannot be further recharged.

**“Batteries, Lead Acid”** means an electrochemical cell encapsulated in a plastic case originally containing lead, lead oxide plates, and sulphuric acid, and that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Beverage Containers”** means a beverage container that meets the requirement of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Biomedical Waste”** means waste as defined in the **Hazardous Waste Regulation** as Biomedical Waste. **Biomedical Waste** does not include **Sharps**.

**“Board”** means the Board of the Cowichan Valley Regional District.

**“Bulky Material”** means a material over 1.25 metres (4 feet) in any dimension or over 100 kilograms (220 pounds) in weight.

**“Concrete”** means a hardened mixture of cement with sand and gravel.

**“Contamination”** or **“Contaminated”** means the presence of another material in one category of **Source-Separated Material**, and includes, but is not limited to:

- a. the commingling of different **Recyclable** materials;
- b. the commingling of different **Controlled Materials**; or
- c. the commingling of two or more of the following categories of material: **Controlled Materials, Garbage, Recyclable Materials** and **Prohibited Waste**.

**Contamination** does not include **Organics, Commingled**.

**“Controlled”** or **“Controlled Materials”** means **Source-Separated Material** accepted at the **Facility** that requires special handling and storage to avoid creating health hazards, nuisances, environmental pollution, or operational challenges for the **CVRD**. **Controlled Materials** are listed in Schedule A.

**“Couches”** or **“Couch”** means upholstered furniture such as loveseats, armchairs, and recliners.

**“Couches, Contaminated”** means a **Couch** that cannot be safely recycled due to it being saturated, infested with liquids, biological matter, parasites, or similar foreign matter.

**“Curbside PPP”** means residential **Packaging and Printed Paper** collected by local curbside collection programs within the **CVRD** but does not include:

- a. **Film Packaging**; or,
- b. **Foam Packaging**

**“CVRD”** means the Cowichan Valley Regional District.

**“Dead Animals and Parts”** means any deceased pets, wildlife, livestock, slaughter remains, or offal thereof, including bones, feathers, skin, or blood.

**“Demolition Waste, ICI”** means construction and demolition waste from:

- a. an **ICI** hauler or **ICI** structure source; or,
- b. a residential source that cannot be contained in a 1.6 metre (5.2 feet) by 2.5 metre (8.2 feet) pickup bed or utility trailer.

**“Demolition Waste, Mixed”** means construction and demolition waste from a residential source that can be contained in a 1.6 metre (5.2 feet) by 2.5 metre (8.2 feet) pickup bed or utility trailer, but has not been **Source-Separated** into categories of **Controlled Material** or **Recyclables**.

**“Drywall”** means building material made from gypsum plaster core bonded between heavy paper and used in construction. **Drywall** may also be referred to as gypsum board, plasterboard, and wallboard.

**“Dusty Material”** means material that can become airborne when being deposited or managed at the **Facility**, which may pose a health risk or impair visibility.

**“Electronic and Electrical Products”** means an electronic and electrical product that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials. Electronic and Electrical Products** include but are not limited to:

- a. **Appliances, Large;**
- b. **Batteries;**
- c. cell phones;
- d. electronic equipment and devices;
- e. information technology and telecommunication equipment;
- f. lamp and lighting equipment;
- g. outdoor power equipment;
- h. small appliances, tools, sport and hobby equipment;
- i. smoke and carbon monoxide alarms; or,
- j. thermostats.

**“Explosives”** means detonating explosives such as trinitrotoluene (TNT) and dynamite, road flares, marine flares, and fireworks.

**“Facility”** or **“Facilities”** means:

- a. Bings Creek Recycling Centre, located at 3900 Drinkwater Road in North Cowichan, British Columbia;
- b. Peerless Road Recycling Centre, located at 10830 Westdowne Road in Ladysmith, British Columbia;
- c. Meade Creek Recycling Centre, located at 8855 Youbou Road in Cowichan Lake, British Columbia.

**“Fibreglass Insulation”** means an insulative material made of glass in a fibrous form.

**“Film Packaging”** means lightweight plastic, overwrap, and other flexible plastic packaging that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Firearm”** means a barreled weapon that readily discharges, or may be readily converted to expel projectiles capable of causing bodily harm or death.

**“Foam Packaging”** means Polystyrene packaging that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Friable”** means material that is crumbled or powdered or can be crumbled or powdered by hand pressure.

**“Garbage”** includes waste of any type that is not:

- a. **Prohibited Material;**
- b. **Organics;**
- c. **Organics, Commingled;**
- d. **Organics, ICI; or,**
- e. **Recyclables.**

**“Gas Cylinders”** means a refillable or non-refillable metal container rated at a capacity of less than 46 kilograms (101 pounds), which is used to contain flammable gases.

**“Glass Packaging”** means clear and coloured glass bottles and jars that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Hazardous Waste”** is as defined in the **Hazardous Waste Regulation** (B.C. Reg. 63/88).

**“Hazardous Waste Regulation”** means the *Hazardous Waste Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 63/88) and all amending regulations under the B.C. *Environmental Management Act*.

**“ICI”** means Industrial, Commercial or Institutional.

**“Industrial Waste”** means any waste originating from an industrial operation including, but not limited to forestry, pulp and paper, mining, or fisheries.

**“Invasive Plants”** means plants that pose a risk to human health, or are difficult to manage through the regular **Yard Waste** process. **Invasive Plants** include, but may not be limited to, Giant Hogweed, Knotweed species, Poison Hemlock, and Spurge Laurel.

**“Landclearing Debris”** means root mats, branches, brush, logs, vegetation, stumps, or other woody debris that does not meet the definition of **Yard Waste**.

**“Licenced Facility”** means a private facility that manages municipal solid waste and/or **Recyclable** material under CVRD Bylaw No. 2570 – *Waste Stream Management Licencing Bylaw, 2004*, and any subsequent amendment of the Bylaw.

**“Liquids or Sludges”** include:

- a. water containing soil, sand, gravel, other non-hazardous solids, or trace levels of petroleum products;
- b. grease;
- c. liquids pumped from:
  - i. parking lot drainage sumps;
  - ii. domestic and municipal sewage treatment plants, sand filters, and pump stations;
  - iii. domestic septic tanks;
  - iv. laundry lint traps;
  - v. grease or oil traps; or,
  - vi. sumps which collect runoff from **Vehicle** washing facilities as well as from facilities used for maintenance or lubrication of automobile components or where solvents or sandblasting are employed for the removal of paint, grease, or oil;
- d. spent charcoal from water purification plants;
- e. sludge from sewerage treatment plants and pump stations;
- f. condemned foods and food processing wastes;
- g. rainwater/natural precipitation; or,
- h. fluids originating from **ICI** or residential **Solid Waste**.

**“Load”** or **“Loads”** means **Solid Waste** that arrives at the **Facility**.

**“Manager”** means the Manager of Recycling and Waste Management of the **CVRD**, or in their absence, their authorized designates.

**“Marketable”** means **Recyclables** or **Controlled Materials** that can be managed through existing recycling markets.

**“Mattress”** means innerspring mattresses, latex foam mattresses, futon mattresses, box springs, or hide-a-beds/pull-out beds.

**“Mattress, Contaminated”** means a **Mattress** that cannot be safely recycled due to it being saturated, contaminated or infested with liquids, biological matter, parasites, or similar foreign matter.

**“Metal”** means recyclable ferrous and non-ferrous metallic materials, including materials with 70% or more metal content and **Appliances, Large** without **ODS**. **Metal** must not include **Bulky Material**.

**“ODS”** means ozone-depleting substances, including but not limited to chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs).

**“Oil”** means lubricating products that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Oil, Cooking”** means plant or animal-based oils used for cooking or frying food.

**“Oil Containers”** means any empty plastic container with a capacity of less than 30 litres that was manufactured to hold lubricating **Oil** and which meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Oil Filters”** means lubricating **Oil** filter products that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Organics”** means compostable material collected from residential generators including:

- a. raw and cooked food wastes, including but not limited to fruits and vegetables, meat, fish, dairy, baked goods, grains, cereal, pasta, egg shells, coffee grounds;
- b. food-soiled paper products, including, but not limited to pizza boxes, paper towels, paper napkins, paper cups, paper plates, and waxed paper fibre products; and,
- c. cut and dried flowers.

**Organics** does not include:

- a. **Organics, Commingled**;
- b. **Organics, ICI**; or
- c. **Yard Waste**.

**“Organics, Commingled”** means a combination of **Organics** and **Yard Waste** collected together by local curbside collection programs within the **CVRD**.

**“Organics, ICI”** means **Organics** collected from Industrial, Commercial, Institutional (**ICI**) sources.

**“Out-of-Region Solid Waste”** means **Loads** or a portion of a **Load** of **Solid Waste** that originates from outside the geographic boundaries of the **CVRD**.

**“Packaging and Printed Paper” or “PPP”** means printed paper and packaging products that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Paint Products”** means paint products and paint containers that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Pesticide Products”** means pest control products that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Petroleum By-Products”** means used lubricating **Oil** that is **Contaminated** with any other products, and any fluid or **Liquids or Sludges** containing fuel or petroleum-based products.

**“Pharmaceutical Products”** means pharmaceutical products that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Plastics, Bulk”** means clean plastic with Society of Plastic Industries (SPI) codes 1-7, but does not include:

- a. **Curbside PPP**;
- b. **Foam Packaging**;
- c. **Film Packaging**;
- d. items without an (SPI) code; and,
- e. items marked with a #3 SPI code (PVC pipes, tiles, etc.)

**“Pressurized Metal Containers”** means refillable and non-refillable propane tanks, butane cylinders, empty fire extinguishers, and bear spray canisters only.

**“Product Stewardship Materials”** means **Solid Waste** included and defined in an approved stewardship plan as defined in the *Recycling Regulation* (B.C. Reg. 449/2004) and all amending regulations under the B.C. *Environmental Management Act*.

**“Prohibited”** or **“Prohibited Material”** means **Solid Waste** prohibited from disposal at the **Facility**, including but not limited to those listed as **Prohibited** under Schedule A.

**“Radioactive Material”** means radioactive waste as defined in the **Hazardous Waste Regulation**.

**“Recyclable”** or **“Recyclables”** means **Marketable** and **Source-Separated** materials listed in Schedule A.

**“Refrigerator, Ammonia”** means a refrigerator unit that contains ammonia-based coolants.

**“Roofing, Asphalt”** means **Asphalt**-based roofing materials including duroid roofing shingles, and tarpaper, but does not include torch-on membrane roofing and shingle wrapping paper.

**“Rubble”** means reusable or recyclable inert granular based material suitable for processing into construction fill material, including, **Asphalt**, brick, **Concrete**, gravel, and rock.

**“Sewage Screenings”** means the material retained by a screen at a sewage treatment facility that has been compressed and dewatered to a solid consistency.

**“Sharps”** means needles, syringes, blades, or other medical sharps capable of causing punctures or cuts, originating from agricultural or residential generators.

**“Soil”** means the earth or dirt in which plants grow, and is a mixture of organic matter, minerals, gases, liquids, and organisms.

**“Solid Waste”** means **Source-Separated Waste** suitable for disposal at the **Facility** and includes:

- a. **Controlled Materials**;
- b. **Recyclables**; and,
- c. **Garbage**

**“Solvents and Flammable Liquids”** means gasoline and all solvents and flammable liquids that meet the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Source-Separated Material”** means **Solid Waste** physically separated into distinct material categories to meet the disposal requirements for **Recyclables**, **Controlled Waste** and **Garbage** of this Bylaw.

**“Tight-head Barrels”** means any metal container with a non-removable top.

**“Tires”** means the outer rubber covering of wheels of **Vehicles**, trucks, bicycles, and motorcycles that meets the requirements of **Product Stewardship Materials**.

**“Tires on Rim”** means **Tires** with metal rims.

**“Unsecured Load”** means a **Load** that is not tied, covered, or otherwise securely attached to the **Vehicle** to prevent any of the **Load** escaping from the **Vehicle**.

**“Vehicle”** means a **Vehicle** as defined by the provincial *Motor Vehicle Act*.

**“Visitor”** means a person who arrives at the **Facility** for purposes other than to deposit **Solid Waste**.

**“Wood, Clean”** means clean, untreated and unpainted wood waste including dimensional lumber and **Wood, Composite**. **Wood, Clean** must not include:

- a. paint or stain exceeding 1% of the total surface area; or
- b. any lead-painted, pressure-treated, or other wood treatment intended to reduce rotting.

**“Wood, Composite”** means wood that has been manufactured into dimensional lumber using glue and/or adhesives, such as particleboard, strand board, plywood, and other similar wood products.

**“Wood, Painted”** means painted, stained or glued furniture wood or wood products where the painted, stained, or glued surface area exceeds 1% of the surface area. **Wood, Painted** does not include:

- a. metal hardware including, but not limited to, door handles and hinges; or,
- b. creosote wood, lead paint, or pressure-treated wood products.

**“Yard Waste”** means grass, lawn and hedge clippings, flowers, weeds, leaves, vegetable stalks, shrubs, branches, and clean stumps less than 13 centimetres (5 inches) in diameter and 1 metre (39 inches) in length, but does not include **Soil** sod, turf, **Yard Waste** from a **Licensed Facility** or **Yard Waste, ICI**.

**“Yard Waste, ICI”** means **Yard Waste** from Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional (**ICI**) sources, including landscape businesses, plant nurseries and farms.



## SCHEDULE A

### TO BYLAW NO. 4412

#### REGULATIONS AND FEES FOR SOLID WASTE

1. Any material-specific disposal requirements are set out in Table 1 - *Fees and Procedures for Depositing Solid Waste* of Schedule A.
2. The minimum fee for any **Solid Waste** deposited at a **Facility** shall be \$7.00.
