i have asked the developer on his previous plan to situate the building so as not so close to my property line and my house.Nothing has changed.

This is a residential neighbourhood .Single family houses.As i do realize there is housing crisis this is not an affordable housing project. i do not feel an apartment build is suited for this neighbourhood .i have discussed this with the developer.

Koksilah rd is a very busy rd.that has heavy industrial traffic with no street lights or sidewalks.

The traffic on Allenby is already a joke with traffic lined up past Polkey rd at times trying to turn left on to th highway to get into Duncan.
