



COWICHAN VALLEY REGIONAL DISTRICT
BYLAW No. 4555

A Bylaw to Amend the Boundaries of the Lake Cowichan Fire Protection Service Area

WHEREAS the Board of the Cowichan Valley Regional District established the *Lake Cowichan District Fire Protection Area* under the provisions of Bylaw No. 1657, cited as "CVRD Bylaw No. 1657 – Lake Cowichan Fire Protection Service Establishment Bylaw, 1994", as amended, for the purpose of providing fire protection and suppression services within portions of Electoral Area F – Cowichan Lake South/Skutz Falls and Electoral Area I – Youbou/Meade Creek;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Cowichan Valley Regional District wishes to extend the boundary of the service area to include the following properties:

- PID: 001-210-076, Plan 30889, Block A, Cowichan Lake District Lot 46 (Civic Address 5892 & 5894 Mayo Road; and
- PID: 003-692-809, Plan 30889, Block A, Cowichan Lake District Lot 46 (Civic Address 5818 Mayo Road.

AND WHEREAS the Regional Board has received sufficient petitions to include these properties within the fire protection service area;

AND WHEREAS the Directors for Electoral Area F - Cowichan Lake South/Skutz Falls and Electoral Area I – Youbou/Meade Creek have consented, in writing, to the adoption of this bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Board of Directors of the Cowichan Valley Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **CITATION**

This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "**CVRD Bylaw No. 4555 – Lake Cowichan Fire Protection Service Amendment (Boundary Extension) Bylaw, 2024**".

2. **AMENDMENT**

That Schedule A to CVRD Bylaw No. 1657 be deleted and replaced with the Schedule A attached to this bylaw.

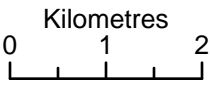
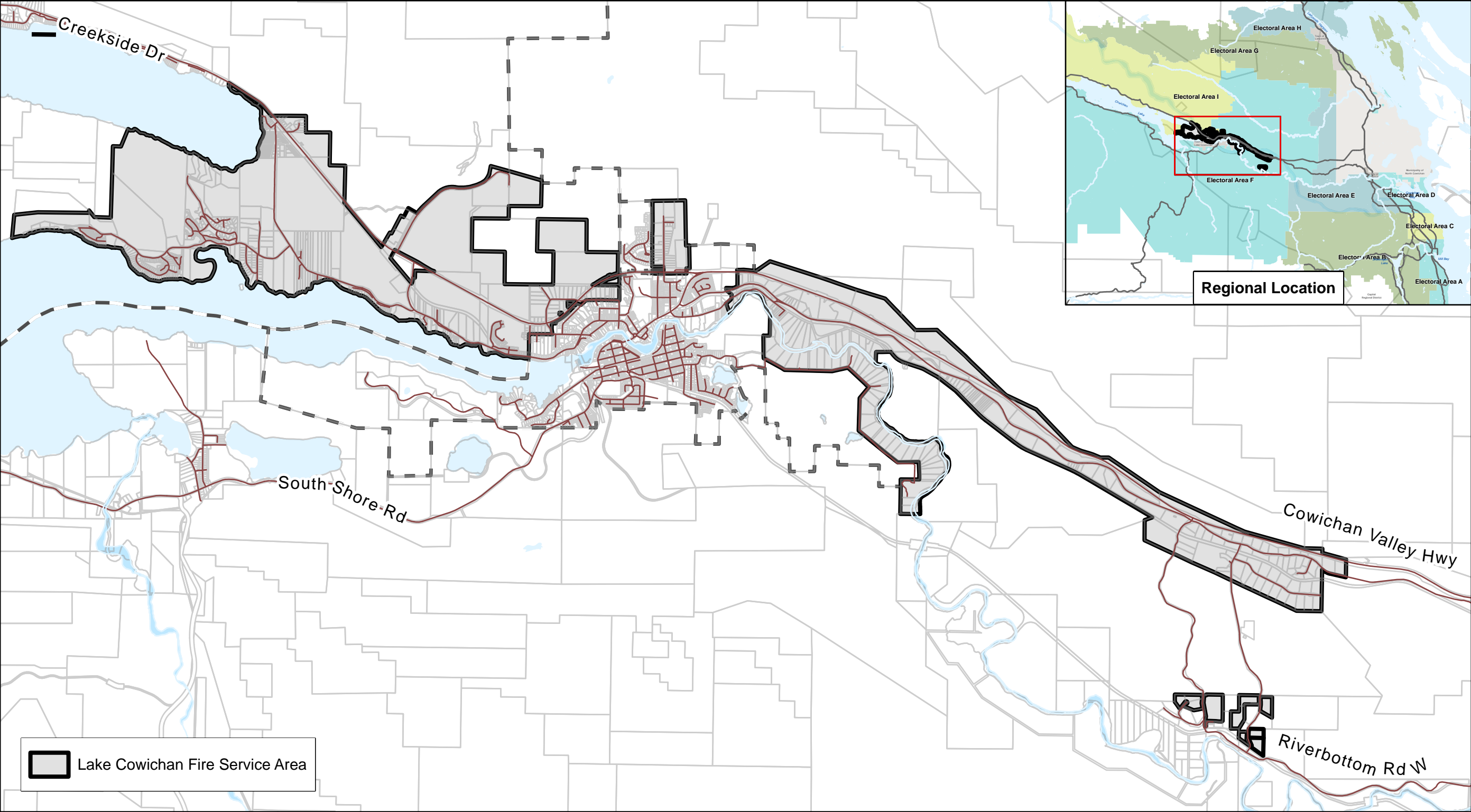
