Re: Cowichan Estuary Environmental Management Committee Letter of Support for Major Restoration Works in Koksilah/Cowichan Estuary

Dear Thomas Reid,

I am writing to confirm the support of the Cowichan Estuary Environmental Management Committee (the Committee) for the proposed Major Restoration Works in Koksilah/Cowichan Estuary (the Project).

The Committee met on August 23, 2022 and discussed the proposal after reviewing relevant materials and a presentation provided by the Proponent. The relevant materials included a letter to the Committee summarizing key background information and key findings from a qualified professional. The professional report documented the existing condition of various diking in the estuary and expected impacts of sea level rise and future storm events. The existing dike structures do not meet Provincial Standards for flood protection and require significant upgrades. Furthermore, the existing dike structures do not provide flood protection during modelled 10-year or 200-year flood events. The Project proposes to remove approximately 1,700 lineal meters (m) of existing diking, thereby leading to the naturalization of approximately 49 hectares (ha) of estuary habitat.

The Committee recognizes that loss and degradation of saltmarsh habitat has resulted from extensive diking for agriculture and other uses. A primary objective of the Cowichan Estuary Environmental Management Plan is to “support rehabilitation of presently degraded habitat in the estuary.” The Project as proposed will make great strides in achieving this objective, and the Project is deemed to be consistent with the objectives of the Cowichan Estuary Environmental Management Plan.
