I am writing this letter to request funds for the purpose of acquiring tools and educational resources for the [educational programs](#) being developed at the Cowichan Community Workshop Co-op, and being held at the Hub at Cowichan Station.

We are currently running a number of woodworking programs for adults as well as youth of the Cowichan Valley community. We are expanding our program offerings quickly to meet the demand of the community and would use the funds for obtaining hand tools for the workshop, and other education related needs to offer courses to the maximum number of participants. Once purchased these hand tools will provide years of service to both workshop members and course participants.

We plan on building treadle powered lathes and shaving horses to provide a range of wood working experiences to connect the community to timeless woodworking skills and traditions.

We hope to also connect with local Indigenous elders to share cross culture teachings related to workshop activities. We feel it's important to include the Aboriginal perspectives and knowledge in our education program.

We have strong community interest from many homeschoolers as well as schools such as Frog Song and Swallow Tail Nature school for workshop classes.

It's my goal as Education Director to put in place the resources needed to support education now and into the future at the Cowichan Community Workshop Co-op. To date a small group of workshop members have volunteered many hours to create a website to support the Education Initiative. The website allows community members to view education offerings, book courses, pay for courses and stay informed about upcoming courses and events.
